Consideration is given to constitutional arrangements and conventions, including the roles of the legislature, executive and judiciary, sub-national government and non-state actors; the significance and policy implications of the Treaty of Waitangi/Te Tiriti o Waitangi; and recent trends in public sector management in various jurisdictions.
